Title: Synopsis for Environmental Characterization and Remediation Services

Proposal Disallowed Reason: This is a synopsis of upcoming acquisition information. Therefore, proposals cannot be submitted directly with this notice. Actual solicitation information will be posted at a later date.

Description:

The Department of Energy (DOE), National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) intends to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to procure environmental characterization and remediation services at designated corrective action sites at various locations where underground nuclear testing or related support activities occurred under the cognizance of the NNSA Nevada Site Office (NSO).

The scope of work will require the contractor to be capable of providing environmental characterization and remediation services for several simultaneous projects at a variety of locations on sites where NSO has environmental restoration responsibility. The services contemplated include: (a) site characterization and assessment studies and streamlined remediation efforts; (b) technical support to assist in planning, management, and execution of the NSO environmental management program; (c) regulatory and policy review; (d) database management; (e) records management and administrative support; and (f) public involvement activities. Required services will be in compliance with RCRA, CERCLA, NEPA, OSHA, appropriate state laws and regulations as well as applicable DOE Orders and regulations.

NNSA plans to issue the RFP late February 2008 or early March 2008 with proposals due approximately April 2008. This requirement will be a competitive, 100% small business set-aside. The applicable North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code for this requirement is 562910, Environmental Remediation Services with a small business size standard of 500 employees. The contract period of performance is anticipated to be a two-year base period with three one-year options.

Competitive proposals will be evaluated based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the solicitation package. Evaluation by the Government will result in the selection of
