The Department of Energy (DOE), National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Request for Proposal (RFP) to procure environmental characterization and remediation services at various locations where underground nuclear support activities have occurred under the cognizance of the NNSA Nevada Site

The scope of work will require the contractor to be capable of providing environmental and remediation services for several simultaneous projects at a variety of locations. The contractor has environmental restoration responsibilities. The services contemplated include: (a) site assessment and assessment studies and streamlined remediation efforts; (b) technical support and management, and execution of the NSO environmental management program; (c) site review; (d) database management; (e) records management and administrative involvement activities. Required services, including assessment/characterization and remediation, will be in accordance with FFACO and will be in compliance with RCRA, CERCLA, NEPA, OS and regulations as well as applicable DOE Orders and regulations.

NNSA plans to issue the RFP late February 2008 or early March 2008 with proposal due by April 2008. This requirement will be a competitive, 100% small business set-aside. The NAICS Code for this requirement is 5622 Remediation Services, with a small business size standard of 500 employees. The performance is anticipated to be a two-year base period with three one-year options.

Competitive proposals will be evaluated based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the solicitation package. Evaluation by the Government will result in the selection of a firm that provides the best value to the Government.

A pre-proposal conference is anticipated to be held after release of the RFP.

Offerors are advised that this requirement may be delayed, cancelled, or revised solicitation, or final award process, and is subject to the availability of funds.
