


The purpose of this modification is to add the paragraph (3) below to paragraph (j) of Clause I.124 INDEMNIFICATION UNDER PUBLIC LAW 85-804 (APR 1984) (Alternate 1) which was added to the contract by modification M059:

- (3) As requested or approved by the President of the United States, the Secretary of Energy, the Deputy Secretary, or the Under Secretary for Nuclear Security, non-proliferation, emergency response, antiterrorism and similar critical national security activities involving the use, detection, identification, assessment, control, containment, dismantlement, characterization, packaging, transportation, movement, storage, or disposal of nuclear, radiological, chemical, biological, or explosive materials, facilities and/or devices; provided that the activity relates to materials that are weapons usable or otherwise have the potential for mass destruction and further provided that the request or approval specifically makes the indemnity provided by this clause applicable to that particular activity.
