Enclosed herewith is a sample copy of the Form G-I.

The purposes of the form are

- (1) to record by whose authority each initiator was accepted, shipped and used;
- (2) to record the date and manner of destruction (including use) so as to permit possible detection of any correlation between design and results;
- (3) to provide an abstract of the history of each initiator during fabrication and acceptance testing as information that may play a role in choosing among several units;
- (4) to provide data that serve to identify the initiator with its record;
- (5) to record the results of measurements made in the field for the benefit of the production studies.

The form is not intended to replace regular laboratory records, and it is considered to be specifically applicable only during the period in which initiator production must be considered experimental. It is hoped that a satisfactory standardized design will emerge from the experimentation so that the paper work can be reduced to merely a record of acceptance, data on the active charge and background records.

For the present it is proposed that four copies of this form be made out for each initiator submitted by the CM Division for possible use, starting with the assignment of the initiator to a numbered case. The data on fabrication and acceptance tests will then be copied from the laboratory records onto these sheets; and, if the unit is acceptable, copies 1 and 2 will be turned over to the G-Engineers with the unit. Copies 3 and 4 will be held in the files of Dodson and Critchfield respectively and completed when copy 1 is returned from the field. Copy 2 will be retained in the files at the field.

Communications to or from the field relating to specific records will refer to the form number, case number, the item numbers appearing on the left of the sheets and to the letters appearing above the several columns in some items.
